Jr. Counselor

Junior Counselor responsibilities include maintenance of the boathouses and equipment, distributing equipment, assisting sailors and instructors on and off the water and putting all equipment away at the end of the day. Starting salary \$8/hour

Counselor

Dates: July 1, 2019 – August 2, 2019. Minimum of 2 weeks required

Hours: 8am – 4:30pm (7:30pm on Friday; some Counselors also work the races on Wednesday until 6:30)

Experience required: 2 years working as an NYSS Jr. Counselor
4-5 years sailing experience with Optis, Laser Picos and Lasers

Requirements: Candidates must be 16 years old
Completion of U.S. Sailing Redbook Beginner Skills
Power boating certificate
Current CPR & First Aid certification
U.S. Sailing counselor course

Counselor responsibilities include moving all equipment, boats and safety boats to the beach for the days' activities, assisting the instructors and students in all on water and off water activities and putting all equipment away at the end of the day. Starting salary \$9/hour

Instructor

Dates: July 1, 2019 – August 2, 2019. All 5 weeks required

Hours: 8am – 4:30pm (7:30pm on Friday)

Experience: 2 years experience as a Counselor
Proficient at sailing Optis, Laser Picos and Lasers

Requirements: Candidates must be 18 years old

Completion of U.S. Sailing Redbook
U.S. Level 1 Certification
Current CPR & First Aid certification
Power boating certificate

Instructors are responsible for writing and teaching all aspects of the weekly lesson plans, overseeing and evaluating support staff, meeting with lead instructor on a daily basis and Waterfront Directors on a weekly basis.

Lead Instructor

Experienced driving power boat

Requirements: U.S. Sailing Level 2 certification

Current CPR & First Aid certification
Power boating certificate

The Lead Instructor is responsible for mentoring staff and instructors, reviewing instructor lesson plans, meeting weekly with Waterfront Directors, assisting with performance evaluations and staffing. Leads Wednesday (races) and Friday night events.
